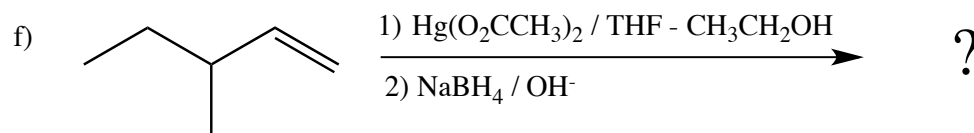
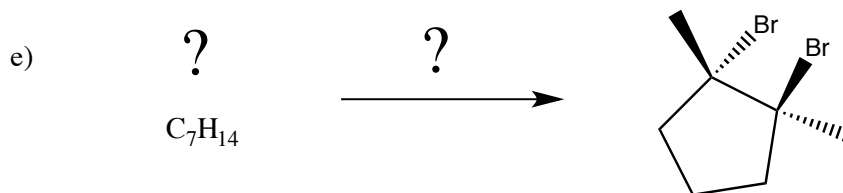
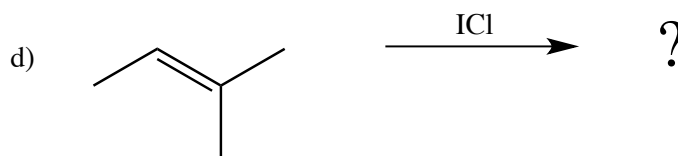
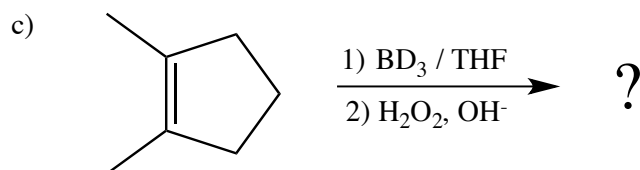
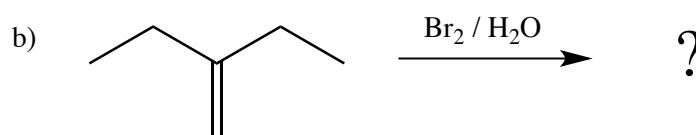
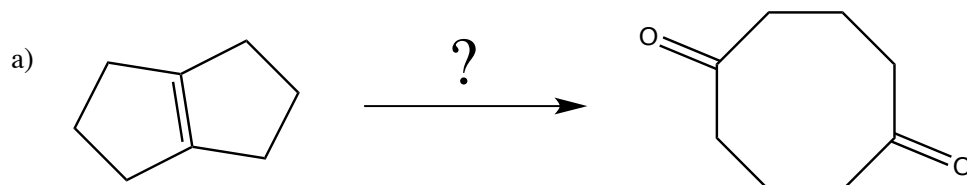
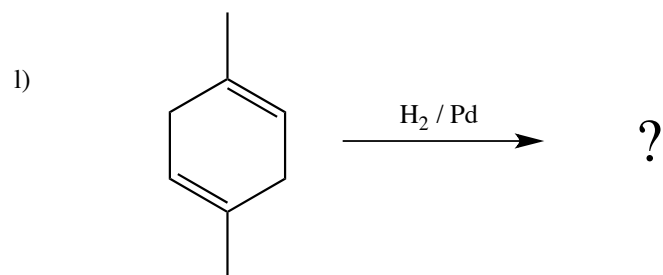
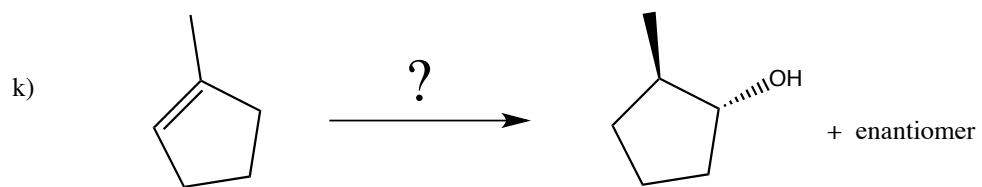
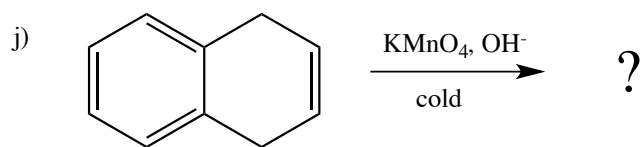
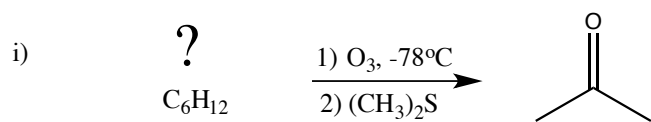
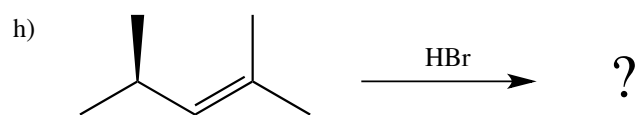
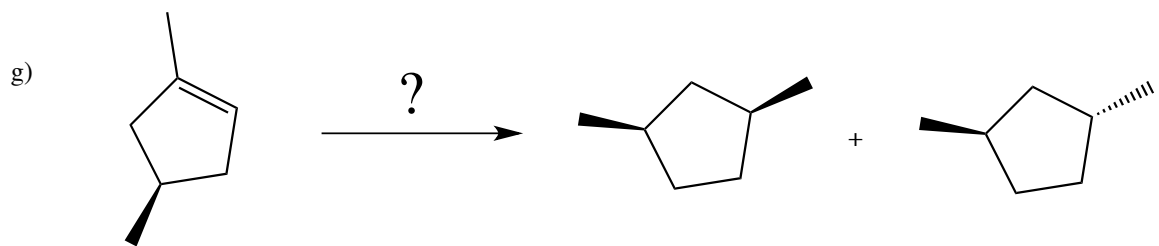


Practice Problems on Alkene Addition Reactions
