APPLICATION DEADLINE EXTENDED TO MARCH 25, 2011!

Eligibility: Applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents with at least a 2.8 G.P.A.. Selection is based on interest in pursuing a career in science, technology, engineering or math (STEM) research that is connected to biology, essay responses, and an interview.

Note: Students who are African-American, Hispanic, Native-American, Southeast Asian, Native Alaskan or Native Pacific Islander; OR from low-income homes and the first in their family to attend college; OR have a documented disability are strongly encouraged to apply.
