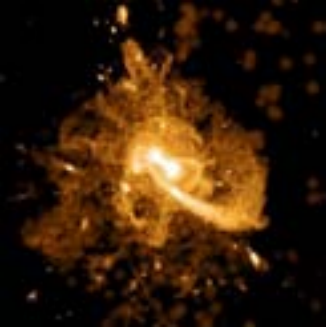

Please send us:

- Your affiliation with UW-Madison (e.g. student, faculty, staff, etc.)
- Statement of permission to reprint your image

Maximum 2 entries per person.

Winners will also receive prizes!
