



# El Salvador: Service Learning

- Explore the land and people of El Salvador from the perspective of international solidarity
- Examine the interaction of the country's political, economic, and cultural systems
- Focus on the development of grass-roots social movements as a means to develop an understanding and connection between people of El Salvador and the U.S.
- Study and promote the practices of consciousness raising, empowerment, and liberation, and explore the meaning of democracy
- Students take LACIS 440 (topics course), for 2 credits in the fall, and 2 credits in the spring in Madison. A 2 credit, two week-long field component in El Salvador the following summer completes this service learning experience.
