

HEALTH INSURANCE FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS IN CHEMISTRY

UW-MADISON

Graduate students at UW Madison receive the option to purchase quality inexpensive health care insurance. You will need to have a 1/3 appointment as a teaching assistant, research assistant, or a fellow. You and your family – spouse, children and domestic partners can enroll in any of the four health maintenance organizations to receive medical services. The rates are listed below.

Coverage & Plan Type	2015 Monthly Rates
Single – HMO	\$46.00
Family – HMO	\$115.00
Single – Standard	\$133.50
Family – Standard	\$333.00

The HMOs coverage includes most of the payment for medical and hospitalizations. The plans provide some dental coverage and an eye exam. The Standard Health plan enables you to choose your own health-care providers. The HMO co-pay for medication is \$5 to \$50 per medication up to an out-of-pocket maximum of \$500 per individual or \$1000 per family. The Standard plan out-of-pocket maximum is \$1000 per individual and \$2000 per family.
