

Installing NUTS on a newer Macintosh with OSX:

updated: 2009-Nov-02

It is now possible to install a version, wxNUTS, onto your Mac. The installation is relatively simple. Note that this is pre-release software, so some features are still missing (inset plots, normalizing integration values, etc.) Here are the instructions:

1. Download the disk image of wxNUTS from the Acorn web site:

Then follow the installation instructions found at the bottom of that page.

2. To activate that to be "real", rather than a demo, you need a license file, which is located in the Macintosh NUTS Transfer Site directory on our snapserver. It is called 'wxNUTS-license.zip' and once unzipped, creates a NUTS-1D site license file, license.txt. Save the license.txt file to the same folder as wxNUTS. Be sure the file's name is not changed when installed, or the program will not recognize it.

3. wxNUTS should not "associate" .fid (the default suffix on VNMR data folders) with its operation. Prior to 2009-10-02, the program would perform this association, causing the data folders to be "packaged" and then to not work properly. The only work-around was to remove the .fid suffix. With the newest version of wxNUTS, this should not happen. If you are upgrading, you may have to associate .fid with something other than wxNUTS. Once this is done, the program should work ok with normal data.

4. Read the "About" screen when the program launches, to be sure it contains personalized information. That will confirm that the license was successfully installed.
